At 0950 this morning deputies responded to 4700 block of Sagewood Rd. in the Comora Loma addition to the report of an armed robbery occurring at a home there.

Deputies spoke to the owners of the home who stated that two men had entered their home apparently through a garage door. The men were armed with a handgun and a knife and bound both of the home owners. The men threatened to kill the victims if they did not cooperate. They bound the victim's wrists and forced the victims to show the location of valuables throughout the house. In addition to money and jewelry they also took three handguns and ammunition. The victims were not physically harmed during the robbery

While the armed men were stealing the victims 2008, white, Toyota FJ Cruiser, the male victim was able to free himself from the wrist restraints and run from the house and yell to a neighbor for assistance. The neighbor saw the robbers fleeing the area in the stolen FJ Cruiser.

The FJ cruiser was recovered about an hour later inside Bingham County in the Jameston town site area.

The descriptions of the armed men are:

Two white males, with darker complexions, both were about 5'11" tall. One man wore a black hooded sweat shirt and one wore a red hooded sweat shirt. One of the robbers spoke with, what the victims described as, a Russian type accent.

Investigators are processing the FJ Cruiser for evidence and following up on leads as we receive them. There was one handgun recovered from the FJ Cruiser.
