On 10-27-2009 the Bonneville County Sheriff's Office received information from U.S. Marshal's Office that a fugitive, Robert C. Kropf, from Utah was suspected to be in our area. Kropf was reported to be armed and dangerous.

Working with the U.S. Marshals, deputies from the Bonneville County Sheriff's Office were able to locate Kropf in the area of 545 Hansen in Idaho Falls. Kropf was driving a 1997 White Ford Expedition when he was located. Deputies attempted to stop Kropf and he fled in the Expedition. Deputies pursued Kropf until his vehicle tires went flat, due to his dangerous and erratic driving, in the area 35th East north of 17th North. Kropf then fled on foot and was apprehended by deputies following a short foot chase, taser deployments and use of a specialty impact munition.

Kropf was hospitalized because of a preexisting medical condition and will be transported to the Bonneville County Jail when he is medically cleared for incarceration. Kropf is being charged locally with Felony Eluding a Peace Officer in addition to his warrant out of Utah for Felony Stalking. Today authorities in Draper, Utah say they are filing additional charges against Kropf.
