The Bonneville County Sheriff's Office reports the arrest of Jason Maurice Hagan age 30 of Idaho Falls, for the Bank Robbery that occurred at Zions Bank in Ammon.

The robbery occurred on September 29th at Zions Bank 2540 E Sunnyside Road. There was only one suspect involved in the robbery. The suspect was driving a newer model Honda Civic.

On October 22nd deputies with the Bonneville County Sheriff's Office received an anonymous call stating that Jason Hagan was the suspect in the robbery. From this information detectives were able to establish probable cause to arrest and obtain a search warrant for Hagan and his home located at 3625 Goldstone. Deputies conducted surveillance on the suspect until they felt that it was safe to make the arrest which occurred at approximately 4 p.m. yesterday afternoon at 1486 Curlew as he exited an apartment of a friend. At the time of his arrest he had been driving the vehicle believed to have been used during the robbery.

Jason Hagan will appear for 1:30 p.m. arraignments where he will be formally charged with a single count of Robbery.
