Male arrested for: Aggravated Battery, DUI, Felony Eluding, Driving Without Privileges

On 12-21-2009 at 3:38 pm the Bonneville County Sheriff's Office was patrolling the area of 129 N 25 E for a vehicle that had been reported as a suspicious vehicle for the past month. The deputy had a vehicle matching the suspicious vehicle pass him on 25th East. When the deputy pulled in behind the vehicle the driver ran the stop sign. The deputy attempted to stop the vehicle with the lights and siren for about a mile before the driver pulled over. When the deputy made contact with the driver the deputy could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. While waiting for a backup deputy to arrive the driver Colin C. McKinley took off from the traffic stop. While the deputies were in pursuit another deputy was stopped at an intersection that they were heading towards. Mr. McKinley ran into the deputy's vehicle that was in the intersection. The deputy that was behind Mr. McKinley performed the Pursuit Immobilization Technique (PIT) stopping the vehicle in a driveway in Jefferson County. The deputies then performed a felony stop and were able to take Mr. McKinley into custody.

Mr. McKinley has been booked into the Bonneville County Jail for Felony Aggravated Battery (running into the deputy's vehicle with the deputy in the vehicle), Felony Eluding a Police Officer, Misdemeanor DUI and Misdemeanor Driving Without Privileges. Mr. McKinley is 50 years old and from Rigby Idaho.
