**Burglary Arrest**

On February 22, 2009 the Bonneville County Sheriff's Office responded to KJ's Travel Center in regards to a graffiti complaint. The deputies were able to locate the suspects as they left the business.

When the deputies contacted the driver of the vehicle Tory James Moore (21 years old from Idaho Falls) they were informed that he had a warrant for his arrest from Idaho Falls. After placing him under arrest and detaining his passenger Zackery Lorin Moore (18 years old from Rigby Idaho) they searched the vehicle incident to the arrest. Inside the vehicle they located numerous stolen items from a residential burglary in the Rimrock Estates area. The Sheriff's Office recovered approximately \$9,500.00 in stolen property.

After looking at the evidence from the burglary both Tory and Zackery were arrested and taken to the Bonneville County Jail.

Tory was charged with felony burglary, misdemeanor possession of marijuana, misdemeanor possession of drug paraphernalia and misdemeanor graffiti.

Zackery was charged with felony burglary, misdemeanor possession of marijuana and misdemeanor possession of drug paraphernalia.
