Vehicle Burglaries and Vehicle Thefts

With the beginning of summer the Bonneville County Sheriff's Office has seen an increase of vehicle burglaries as well as vehicle thefts.

The Sheriff's Office would like to remind the public to lock their vehicles and to keep valuable items out of their vehicles. Most of the burglaries happened to vehicles that had the doors unlocked and valuable items were left in the view of the public.

In regards to the vehicle thefts the Sheriff's Office has taken 8 stolen vehicle reports in the last month and a half. Most of the vehicles that have been stolen were unlocked and the keys were in the vehicle. The Sheriff's Office would like to remind the public to lock their vehicle doors and to not leave your keys in the vehicles.

The public should park their vehicles in well light areas, keep their vehicles lock, keep valuables out of the view of the public and call your local law enforcement if you see someone suspicious in your neighborhoods.
