High Risk Warrant Service

On July 12, 2011 at 2345 Bonneville County Sheriff's Office called out our tactical team to serve a warrant on a known felon with possible weapons.

U.S. Marshalls office had information that David D. Geisser, 43 year old from Sandy Utah was at a home in Ammon. Earlier in the day in Sandy, Utah, two repossession officers tried to repossess a vehicle from Geisser. He pulled a gun on them and drove off in the car.

Detectives watched the home at 3170 Molen in Ammon. They confirmed the vehicle that Geissler had been driving was at that residence. They also confirmed that a male matching his description was at the home.

Geisser has had multiple felony convictions including robbery. With this information and the earlier incident in Utah, we called out our tactical team to serve the warrant. Geisser was taken into custody without incident.

He was booked into the Bonneville County Jail on a parole violation out of Utah with no bond.
