On March 13, 2011 at 1654 deputies responded to an assault call involving a gun. It was reported that a man was shooting towards people walking in the area.

Patrol Deputies attempted to make contact with the suspect at 6275 Sidehill Lane. No one answered the door. Patrol deputies maintained a perimeter and our SWAT team was requested.

At 1901 multiple SWAT members were in place. While maintaining the perimeter, One deputy was covering the north west portion of the home.

At 1940 a dog started barking in his direction. A female inside the home was looking toward the deputy with a pair of binoculars. She looked directly at the deputy. Due to a compromised location, the deputy lowered himself into a canal. As he lowered himself, a male inside the home started shooting through an open window towards the deputy.

At 1946 the female walked out of the house. She was secured and moved away from the house. After verbal negotiations with the male he came out of the house unarmed at 1954.

Brian Woloshyn, 48 year old male, was arrested and charged with three counts of aggravated assault.
