On January 3, 2011 Bonneville County Sheriff's Office took a report of vandalism at 444 Bone Road. B.P. Wind Energy reported that a windmill had been shot twice. The bullets hit the top of the windmill causing damage inside the windmill housing. It damaged hoses, wiring, and other equipment. The estimated repairs are near \$ 5000.

This damage was noticed on December 22, 2010. The shooting took place some time prior to that date.

This vandalism is a Felony Crime punishable by imprisonment in the State Prison up to five years and a fine of a \$1000. In addition costs of restitution for the repairs.

The windmill was on the South East side of the Bone Road, it is about a mile East of Lincoln Road.
