This is an update on a case from January 5, 2011, a report of a moving vehicle being shot at on 17th Street in Ammon. Camillo Villa-Guillen was east bound on 17th Street. He had his 14 year old son in the car with him. He was driving a 1995 Pontiac Grand Am.

There was another car in traffic traveling the same direction. It had five occupants in the vehicle. There was a situation involving a disturbance where a person inside the second vehicle shot at the Grand Am. The bullet struck the rear passenger door of the car.

On March 13, 2011 a warrant was requested for discharging a firearm at an occupied motor vehicle.

On March 15, 2011 a warrant was served on Corey Kent at the Bonneville County Jail. He had been previously arrested on Vehicle Burglary charges on January 29, 2011. Kent is an 18 year old from Ammon.

If found guilty of a charge of discharging a firearm at an occupied vehicle. Kent could be sentenced to up to 15 years in prison.
