Three adults arrested for Felony Burglary of the Ammon Wal-mart.

At 0302 this morning a Wal-mart employee from Ammon called dispatch in reference to an attempted burglary inside the store. Idaho Falls Police located the suspect vehicle on Hitt Road that had left the scene.

A Bonneville County Detective that had been assigned to the case was called to the scene of the traffic stop. Idaho Falls Police Officers confirmed a possible involvement with a previous burglary at the same location.

Three adult males were arrested for the April 11, 2011 Burglary at the Ammon Wal-mart. . The April 11th Burglary occurred in the early morning hours, where four individuals took \$9150 in merchandise.

Drew Bussell 18, Guillermo Miramontes 19, Valentin Sigala 18 all from Salt Lake City Utah were arrested.

They were caught trying to commit another burglary inside of the store this morning. They had loaded up a couple of shopping carts, when they were confronted by Wal-mart employees in the garden area. They left the store and were stopped on Hitt Road.
