

## For Immediate Press Release

On 08-17-2011, Bonneville County Deputies and Idaho Falls Police responded to a 911 call in regards to a male subject being robbed and then bound and placed in his vehicle. The subject was able to dial 911 and was located by law enforcement.

According to the report, the male subject had stopped to help 3 male subjects near the intersection of 97<sup>th</sup> South and 15<sup>th</sup> East who were parked in the road. After the male subject exited his vehicle, he was attacked by three males who assaulted him and then bound his hands, feet and mouth and put him in the back of his Ford Explorer. It was discovered after being located by law enforcement that the male subject had been robbed of an undisclosed amount of money.

The male subject described the offenders as three male Hispanics; two of the males were wearing white hoodies. One of the offenders was said to have a tattoo on his face. The offender's vehicle was said to be an older blue Chevrolet or Oldsmobile 4-door passenger vehicle with 8B plates. The vehicle was said to be "lowered" with possibly chrome wheels or hubcaps.

During the attack, the subject stated that two vehicles drove by his location, one being a white Suburban type vehicle.
