

Snowmobiling is an exciting and wonderful way to enjoy the great outdoors during the winter months. With the winter season upon us the Bonneville County Sheriff's Office would like to remind snowmobile users to register their snowmobiles.

Idaho law 67-7102 states that no snowmobile shall be operated within the jurisdiction of the State of Idaho unless registered.

Registration fees are \$32.50 per snowmobile. They can be purchased at snowmobile dealers or at Idaho State Parks and Recreation offices. A portion of the proceeds from snowmobile registrations help pay for local trails to be groomed.

A citation is \$76.50 if issued by local law enforcement. There are significantly higher if cited by Forest Service Officers. If you do not have your snowmobile registration a citation will be issued.

We would like all members of the community to have a great time while recreating in the back country.

Please take the steps necessary to enjoy your trip.

Wear a helmet and dress appropriately.

Let someone know where you are going and when you expect to be back.

Slow down, especially at night.

Be on the lookout for obstacles like slow grooming equipment, wildlife, and oncoming sleds or skiers.

Please don't drink and drive, Alcohol and snowmobiles do not go good together.

Carry a first aid kit.

If in an area where there is an avalanche risk, please have beacons and appropriate equipment.
